ENTRIES CLOSE ON SATURDAY 16 JUNE

Floral Art Co-ordinator:
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Regulations

1. The judges' decisions shall be final, unless a protest in writing against a decision by them be lodged with the Floral Art Co-ordinator by 2pm on the day of judging.
2. **STAGING TIMES** Club Class may be staged from 2pm and other Classes from 3pm on Tuesday 26 June 2018. **The marquee must be vacated by 10pm on Tuesday.** Access for checking exhibits will be allowed from 6.0-6.30am on Wednesday, prior to commencement of judging at 6.45am.
3. Exhibits **MUST NOT** be removed before 5pm on Thursday.
4. Nothing may be attached to the staging background.
All exhibits to be viewed and judged from the front unless otherwise stated.
5. An exhibitor may place only one entry in each class.
6. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis depending on the availability of space. All entries will be acknowledged but **ONLY** if accompanied by a **SAE** or **email address**.
7. All exhibits and exhibitors' property will be at the risk of the exhibitor. The NNHS and the RNAA cannot be held responsible in any way for any loss or damage sustained by the exhibitor.
8. Exhibitors' cards **MUST** be collected from the Floral Art Co-ordinator and displayed face down on the exhibit prior to judging.
9. All exhibits must be the unaided work of the competitor and must be assembled in the marquee with the exception of Classes F3, F5, F8 & F9 which may be submitted already assembled.
10. **ALL MEASUREMENTS GIVEN ARE APPROXIMATE.** All exhibits in Classes F1-F9, with the exception of Class F3, to be judged in accordance with the **NAFAS Competitions Manual 3rd Edition 2015.**
Exhibitors in Class F1 & F2 should be aware that the height of the marquee wall is 2.75 metres after which height could be restricted.
11. Aerosol sprays **MUST NOT** be used in the marquee.
12. Novices may enter any class but the NOVICE CLASS is open only to competitors who have never won a First Prize in Flower Arranging Classes at any NNHS or NAFAS Show.
13. The Club Class (F1) is not eligible for Best-in-Show Award.
14. **ALL RUBBISH TO BE REMOVED BY THE EXHIBITOR(S).**

TICKETS

With the exception of Classes F5 and F9, each exhibitor will receive one ticket for entry into the Showground together with a car park pass. [Further entrance tickets to the Show can be obtained in advance from several local supermarkets (see local Press for details).]

A car park pass will be available for those delivering and collecting exhibits in Classes F5 and F9. An entry ticket to the Show is not required after 4.0pm on Thursday.

CLASS F1 VOTES FOR WOMEN! (CLUB CLASS)

OPEN TO ANY FLOWER CLUB OR HORTICULTURAL SOCIETY.

An exhibit to be staged on a round 120cm diameter base provided and raised approx.10cm from ground. Own covering and skirt to be provided. Height optional. To be viewed all round and judged from the front.
(See Reg. 10 re. height)

CLASS F2 THE CENTENARY OF THE RAF

A pedestal exhibit. Space allowed: width 120cm; depth 120cm. Own base optional. To be viewed and judged from the front. Background grey. Height optional. (See Reg.10 re. height)

CLASS F3 'I DO' - A BOUQUET FIT FOR A ROYAL (FLORISTRY CLASS)

On foam, wired or tied designs acceptable.

Space allowed 50cm width x 80cm depth. No height restriction. Staged on tabling 65cm from ground, staging grey. Please supply own display stand/material.

This Class will be judged under Society of Floristry Rules (a copy of marking sheet is available from the Floral Art Co-ordinator).

CLASS F4 CAPABILITY BROWN

A landscape exhibit. Space allowed: width 90cm; depth 80cm; height 120cm. Staged on tabling 65cm from ground. Staging and background grey.

CLASS F5 HAPPY ANNIVERSARY (PETITE CLASS)

An exhibit. Space allowed: width 25cm; depth 25cm; height 37cm. Tiered staging on tabling 65cm from ground. Staging and background grey. May be brought ready assembled. Title to be displayed.

CLASS F6 250 YEARS OF THE CIRCUS

An exhibit. Space allowed: width 70cm; depth 80cm; height 120cm. Staged on tabling 65cm from ground. Staging and background grey.

Class F7 'CELEBRITY CHEFS' (NOVICE CLASS)

An exhibit. Space allowed: width 70cm; depth 80cm; height 120cm. Staged on tabling 65cm from ground. Staging and background grey. (See Reg.12.)

Class F8 BLUE PLANET (CRAFT CLASS)

A collage not to exceed 40cm x 25cm. Staged on tabling 65cm from the ground. Staging and background grey. May be brought ready assembled. Own stand to be provided.

Class F9 MYTHS AND LEGENDS (JUNIOR CLASS - see note opposite*)

An exhibit. Space allowed: 25cm x 25cm. Fresh and/or dried plant material. May be brought ready assembled. To be delivered to flower marquee between 2.00pm and 10.00pm on Tuesday. Not to be collected before 5.00pm on Thursday.
